

## CAPH/SNI 2022 Annual Conference COVID-19 Policy

CAPH/SNI is closely monitoring the evolving COVID-19 situation and will comply with the latest guidance from relevant government and health agencies.

We are taking steps to ensure a safe and healthy environment for all attendees. See below for a summary of CAPH/SNI's COVID-19 policies:

- Attendees must show proof of up-to-date vaccination status\*
- Meeting rooms will be setup for appropriate physical distancing
- Clear signage will be provided about safety protocols
- At the event, the following items will be available:
  - Facial masks and antibacterial sanitizer
  - Antibacterial wipes for podiums, shared spaces, and equipment
  - Hand-sanitizing stations and disposable disinfectant cloths

Although masks will be available on-site, we strongly encourage attendees to bring their own masks that cover the nose and mouth, fit snugly against the sides of the face, and can be worn comfortably.

In addition to the above protocols, the Meritage Resort and Spa follows the [City of Napa's](#) COVID-19 guidance. Currently, there are no physical distancing mandates in Napa. However, we ask attendees to be mindful of fellow attendees who might be less comfortable with close contact or sharing spaces.

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*\*In accordance with CAPH/SNI policy, up-to-date vaccination status is defined as having received the last required dose of a CDC- or WHO-recognized COVID-19 vaccine and a follow-up booster shot, if applicable, at least two weeks before the start date of the conference or event. We are unable to accept alternatives to vaccination, such as a negative COVID-19 test or immunity from prior infection. This requirement is consistent with a growing trend for conferences and events and activities. CAPH/SNI also requires all employees to be up-to-date on coronavirus vaccinations.*
